Actions for Subject Leader this term:

- Work with Warrington Grace group to develop moderation across 6 schools,
- Develop further moderation opportunities within the wider Grace group through the collection of evidence.
- Investigate wow moments with workbooks and blue celebration books in relation to SIAMs conversation and data.
- Look at teaching opportunities to develop greater depth knowledge 1:1 coaching and whole school training.
- Develop first hand learning opportunities through the story project.
